## **Notes on the Wasdale & Scafell Pike Walk.**

This walk is to be held on Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> April 2008. It is possible that we may encounter full winter conditions, in which case we may not be able to visit the summit of Scafell Pike. Even in summer conditions, foul weather may prevent our group from reaching the summit.

Each walker is expected to bring all walking equipment and clothing as detailed in the 'Walkers Kit List'. If you are not fully equipped, we may not allow you to walk with us. Please let us know in advance if you would like to use any of our walking equipment.

Wasdale is probably a lot further from the M6 than you think. Please make sure you allow enough time to get to the meeting point by 10am. No mobile phone reception is available – so you will not be able to advise us if you are going to be late..! Stay overnight near Wasdale beforehand if possible.

This walk is not a test of fitness or endurance, but an opportunity of walking through the route, taking time to note navigational features, having a go at map and compass work (or GPS if you have one), and get to use some emergency equipment, whilst with some qualified and experienced mountain leaders – and challenge organisers.

The ratio of leaders to walkers will be approximately 1:8

After we have returned to Wasdale, we will normally stay for a few drinks in the Wasdale Head Inn. Please feel free to join us – it's a great chance to ask those questions...

### **Walk Itinerary:**

1000: Meet at 'The Green', Wasdale. Short safety briefing & kit check.  
1020: Depart Wasdale for Scafell Pike summit.  
1330: Reach summit, lunch on top.  
1700: Return to Wasdale. Drinks at Wasdale Head Inn.

### **This walk includes:**

MLTE qualified instructor (1 per 8 walkers)  
Laminated A4 map of navigation area  
Laminated Beacon Guide licenced by Harvey Maps.  
Use of VHF radio safety comms  
Use of emergency group shelters

### **Not included:**

Any food or drinks  
Drinks after the course at Wasdale Head Inn  
Any accommodation
